Presidency IV Huge Success

Governor Charlie Crist and Republican Party of Florida Chairman Jim Greer introduced the Republican Presidential candidates at the Presidency IV Presidential Rally where more than 3,000 activists assembled at the Shingle Creek Resort in Orlando. This event provided an exciting opportunity for the selected ambassadors to learn more about the exceptional leaders running for the highest office in the land. Presidency IV gave Republicans of Florida a chance to learn more about the candidates and their positions on key issues. Since Florida's primary election is less than three months away, Presidency IV will have helped these voters to make an informed decision on election day.

The Republican presidential candidates in attendance for the Presidency IV rally were Mayor Rudy Giuliani, Senator John McCain, Governor Mitt Romney and Senator Fred Thompson. The candidates each addressed Republican Party of Florida grassroots activists and elected officials, and they shared their vision for the nation's future. The Presidential rally attendees had a remarkable opportunity to hear from the Republican candidates directly without their messages being filtered through the media.

Presidency IV culminated with a nationally-televised, prime-time debate presented on Fox News Channel.
