In accordance with section 100.111(3), Florida Statutes and the Republican Party of Florida (RPOF) Rules of Procedure, the members of the RPOF State Executive Committee comprising Hillsborough and Pinellas counties will meet on Friday, August 14th, at 6:30pm to designate a nominee to fill the vacancy created by the withdrawal of State Representative James “J.W.” Grant. The Secretary of State provided notification to the RPOF Chairman on Wednesday, August 12th of the existence of a vacancy in nomination for House District 64. By law, the RPOF has seven (7) days to submit the name of the person designated to fill the vacancy in nomination to the Secretary of State. The RPOF’s designation and the qualifying papers for the nominee must be submitted to the Division of Elections no later than 5 p.m. on August 19, 2020.

All interested and qualified candidates should submit a resume and letter of intent to RPOF Senior Director George Riley at: griley@rpof.org **no later than noon on Friday, August 14th.**

At the meeting, voting members of the State Executive Committee in Hillsborough and Pinellas counties may nominate individuals for consideration of designation. According to the RPOF Rules, a person must receive a majority of the vote to be designated and the vote will be cast proportionately to each county’s percentage of the total Republican Party registration within House District 64 and allocated equally to each voting member present.
